

LICENSING ACT 2003: Premises licence Application

Concerns

Very poor parking both at the front and rear of the property.

Access to properties to the rear of the building are constantly being blocked today so it will only get worse.

Music noise levels from the property need to be restricted.

Noise levels due to deliveries and waste disposal will disturb local neighbours and therefore need to be restricted / managed.

Surrounding properties will be disturbed when people are leaving the bar in the late hours. Suggest closing off the rear car park at say 20.00 Hrs.

Note

Previous bar by the applicant (the Grotto in the old Longton Post Office) was noisy and caused disturbance in the area so there is no reason to expect this bar will be any better.

Suggest restrictions are put in place to protect the local community.
