

Capital Project/Corporate Priority	Cabinet Member	Project Description
Central Parks - St Catherine's Park	Cllr Cliff Hughes	This project will see us work in partnership with St Catherine's Hospice to link their site off Lostock Lane to the land owned by SRBC at Dandy Brook. The first Phase of the project has seen us support the development of a Peace Garden & the erection of a World War 1 Memorial for the Borough. The second phase will see us improve access along the footpaths on SRBC land, construct an additional footbridge across Dandy Brook, & improve access to the wetlands & wooded area by opening up access through the construction of an ornate gate. Phase One was completed on schedule in November 2015 & Phase Two is due for completion in June 2016.

Work to improve facilities at Lostock St Gerard's football ground	Cllr Graham Walton	Liaising with Eastern Neighbourhood Forum, carry out a feasibility study for options to improve facilities at Lostock St Gerard's football ground.
Work with partners to improve Farington Lodges	Cllr Graham Walton	Work with partners to secure funding / carry out further improvement works to Farington fishing lodges, footpaths and disabled accessibility. A feasibility study of de-silting the lake and creating a pond dipping facility for local schoolchildren also needs scoping out in 2016.
Lostock Hall Market	Cllr Renee Blow	Continue to support the market which now operates on the first Thursday of every month. The market has proved popular with customers and stallholders & in 2015 we have seen the introduction of weekly greengrocery & fishmongers stalls on Hope Terrace. The overall aim of this project is to increase the sustainability of the event to a point where it can be self-managed.
Townsway Community Orchard	Cllr Jacqui Mort	Work with the local community to establish a 'friends' group for the orchard. Support the group to maintain the site and sustain Townsway Orchard as a 'pick as you pass' amenity for everyone to enjoy.
Lostock Hall Academy Arts Trail	Cllr Karen Walton	Work with staff & pupils at Lostock Hall Academy with the aim of developing an Arts Trail in the newly developed St Catherine's Park.
Lostock Hall in Bloom	Cllr Karen Walton	Carry out a feasibility study in March 2016 to gauge the potential interest of residents, partners & local businesses in brightening up Lostock Hall through involvement with 'In Bloom'.
Farington Park Outdoor Gym	Cllr Paul Wharton	Support Farington Parish Council in developing a consultation process with residents & interested parties to assess the need for an 'Outdoor Gym' on Farington Park, & subject to need being proven, support them in a bidding process to lever in external funding.
Reserve Projects	Responsible Member	Project Description
Develop a footpath & cycle route network	Cllr Jacqui Mort	Seeking to improve existing public footpaths and cycle routes within Central area. New links have been developed to join up existing paths, & enable residents to make more use of them & give greater access to local open spaces.
Hope Gardens, Lostock Hall	Cllr Cliff Hughes	An aspirational project to develop a new nature park/play area in Lostock Hall, which could include a peace garden & off road cycle track, making use of derelict land. No activity to date due to lack of funding.

Central Neighbourhood Forum

They are supported by your local Community Involvement Officer, who works with communities and groups in your area to make things happen.

Every My Neighbourhood forum has a 'core fund' provided by the council - each year, the Central area receives £3500 to spend on local initiatives.

For bigger projects, where there are links to Council's Corporate Plan, capital funds, such as Section 106 funding from developments may be available.
