SUMMARY AND LINK TO CORPORATE PRIORITIES

- 2. Letters were sent out to licensed Hackney Carriage Vehicle Proprietors and Hackney Carriage Drivers asking if they were 'For' or 'Against' the proposals put forward by the 'South Ribble Taxi Owners Association' (see Appendix A).
- 3. A total number of <u>148 letters</u> were sent out in the post to the above on 3rd December 2014 and responses had to be in by no later than Friday 2nd January 2015.
