Application approved (Policy states should be “generally refused” but GLC found grounds to depart from Policy)	N/A
C	18.10.16	Existing licence holder	Inappropriate comments made to vulnerable 16 year old female passenger	Allowed to retain licence but severe warning placed on file	No
D	17.1.17	New application	Five convictions for various drink related offences between 2005 and 2009. 2008 conviction for theft.	Application refused due to convictions and medical grounds	No
E	17.1.17	Existing licence holder	Information received from Home Office that driver did not have any legal entitlement to work in this country	SO38 – revoked by Chief Executive and Chair of GLC under emergency procedure	No
