I would like to vigorously oppose the license for the shop located at 41 Moss Lane Leyland.

Having witnessed and reported two underage sales myself as well as being able to provide video evidence of one of the sales to the Police it is abundantly clear after two further failures made by the Licensing section that the owner(s) of this premises are intent on making a significant negative impact on our community for the sake of financial gain with little, if any, interest to the frequent problems associated with anti-social behaviour brought about by underage drinkers.

A considerable number of young people who are not residents of Moss Lane are now frequenting Moss Lane since the shop has changed hands, it is noticeable that graffiti in the area has increased as has the amounts of empty cans and bottles of alcohol in a number of areas in particular the underpass.

Since the shop changed owners it has also brought other problems with extended opening hours and shop paraphernalia being left on the pavement etc but those are issues not covered by your remit however it would be appreciated if these could be noted along with the simple fact that there was not a single problem from the previous owner Mr Lad.

I trust the Licensing committee will deal with anyone failing to meet their legal requirements, oppose the application for the premises on Moss Lane and send the clear message to anyone else with similar intent that their negative actions will not be tolerated.
