ANNEX 1- MANDATORY CONDITIONS

SALE OF ALCOHOL

1. The Premises licence holder shall ensure that no supply of alcohol is made under the premises licence- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence; or (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended (section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003)
2. The Premises licence holder shall ensure that every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorized by a person who holds a personal licence (section 19 of the Licensing Act 2003).

SECURITY PROVISION

1. The Premises licence holder shall ensure that each individual present on the premises to carry out a security activity [as defined by paragraph 2(1) (a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001] must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

No irresponsible sales promotions of alcoholic beverages shall be offered to customers.

No customers carrying open or sealed bottles shall be admitted to the premises at any time the premises are open to the public.

A sign will be displayed on the premises indication the standard hours during which the sale of alcohol is permitted.

All fire doors will be maintained effectively self closing and shall not be held open other than by approved devices.

Notices detailing the actions to be taken in the event of fire or other emergencies, including how the fire brigade shall be summoned, are to be prominently displayed

No regulated entertainment of any type shall take place outside the premises in any areas which are within the licence-

holder's control after 22.00 save for any special event seven days notice of which has been given to the licensing authority and police

When amplified musical entertainment is taking place inside the premises after 22.00 windows and doors, save for entrance and exit purposes, will be kept shut.

A sign will be located at the exit(s) requesting that customers leaving the premises do so quietly and with consideration to neighbours

No one under the age of 16 will be allowed to enter or remain on the premises after 22.00 save on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

Anyone who appears to be under the age of 18 and who is attempting to buy alcohol must be required to produce proof of age before such a sale is made

Recorded Music to be reduced in volume and tempo to background levels after midnight. Christmas Eve, Boxing Day and New Year's Eve the music must be reduced after 01.00.

When Regulated Entertainment is taking place doors and windows, save for entrance and exit purposes, shall be closed with the internal doors fitted with closers.

The DPS or his/her representative shall undertake assessments outside the premises when regulated entertainment is taking place, to assess the level of noise and reduce the volume if necessary. These arrangements should be recorded in a log book.

ON-LICENCES - PERMITTED HOURS

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. This restriction does not prohibit:

- (a) sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- (b) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- (c) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- (d) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;
- (e) the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
- (f) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- (g) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

ON-LICENSED PREMISES - CREDIT SALES

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied:

- (a) with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal;
- (b) for consumption by a person residing in the premises or his guest and paid for together with his accommodation;
- (c) to a canteen or mess.

ON-LICENCE WITH NO CHILDREN'S CERTIFICATE

No person under fourteen shall be in the bar of the licensed premises during the permitted hours unless one of the following applies:

- (1) He is the child of the licensee (DPS).
- (2) He resides in the premises, but is not employed there
- (3) He is in the bar solely for the purpose of passing to or from some part of the premises which is not a bar and to or from which there is no other convenient means of access or egress
- (4) The bar is in railway refreshment rooms or other premises constructed, fitted and intended to be used bona fide for any purpose to which the holding of the licence is ancillary

In this condition 'bar' includes any place exclusively or mainly used for the consumption of intoxicating liquor. But an area is not a bar when it is usual for it to be, and it is, set apart for the service of table meals and alcohol is only sold or supplied to persons as an ancillary to their table meals.
