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- NOT UNIQUE TO SOUTH RIBBLE & CHORLEY

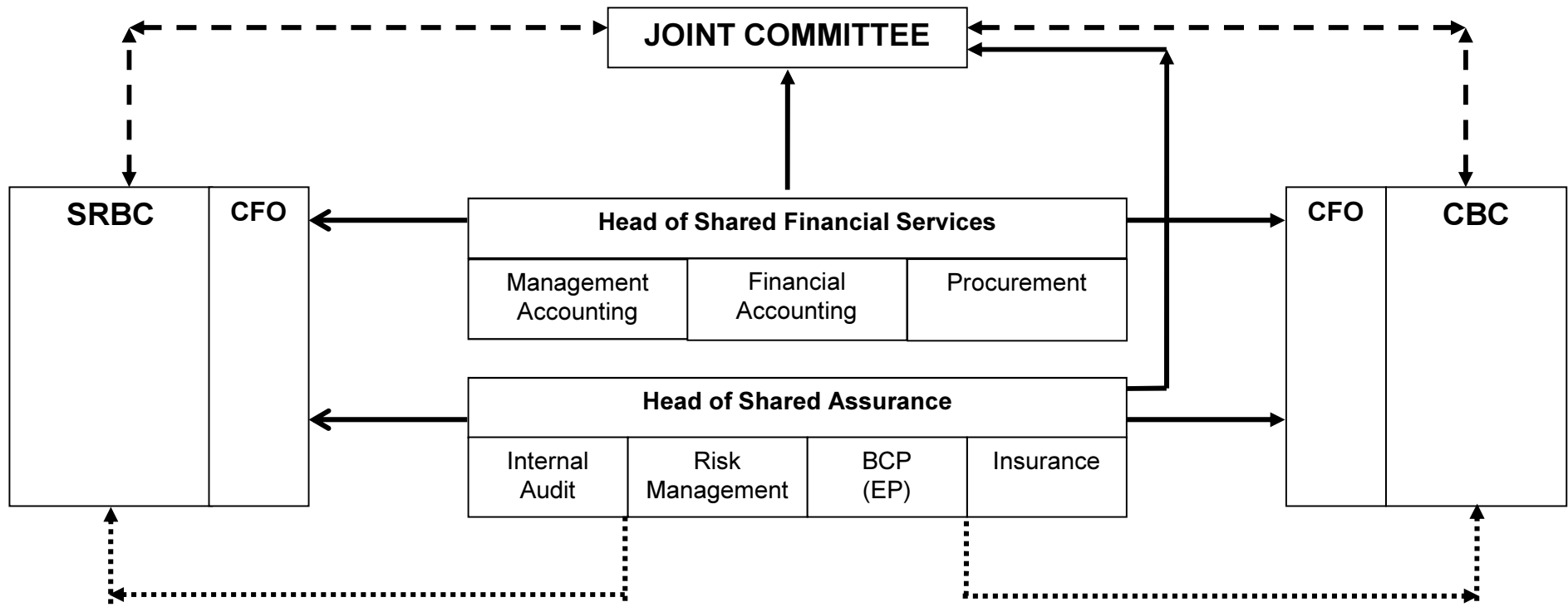
Approach

 - Draw on best practice
- Increased opportunities
- Improved leadership and future direction

Core Principles

- Joint Committee governance arrangements
- “Hosting” by each council of individual services
- Creation and recruitment to two joint senior posts to lead the Finance and Assurance functions
- Employees transferred to the respective councils “hosting” services (TUPE 5/1/09)
- Recurrent costs shared equally in the initial phases of the implementation.
