Decision:	Permission for Leyland and Farington Neighbourhood Forum to allocate and spend core funds of up to £300 to support the Love Leyland and Farington project (Ulnes Walton Bridleway Association - Support for Volunteering)
Details and Reasoning:	<p>Introduction Leyland and Farington Neighbourhood Plan includes the following project: Love Leyland and Farington</p> <p>Background Ulnes Walton Bridleway Association is a local charity which seeks to improve safety for horse-riders and pedestrians, particularly on roads where there are no bridleways. The group raises money to fund community projects, and to make contributions to local causes.</p> <p>Over recent years, UWBA volunteers have worked with many partners to deliver the following projects. Input has ranged from lobbying statutory agencies to securing external funding and grants to designing new off-road routes.</p> <p>In addition, UWBA have supported several local projects such as the successful Sport England bid to create a new clubhouse for Leyland Warriors and 'Bobby the Horse' gateway feature. Horseshoes used to create the sculpture were donated by UWBA riders; they are understandably proud of such a significant monument to recognise horses are a key part of Leyland's heritage.</p> <p>On an ongoing basis, the group host charity events, most recently a memorial ride which raised funds for St Catherine's Hospice. UWBA volunteers regularly give their time to help other community groups, riding clubs and new / novice riders.</p> <p>Proposal In order to support UWBA to continue their work going forward, it is proposed that the Leyland and Farington Forum provides a working fund of £300. This relatively small amount will cover costs which grants do not cover, such as providing refreshments for volunteers and printing publicity materials.</p> <p>It is proposed that the Leyland and Farington Forum request an allocation of £300 from core funds to support the project.</p>
