Introduction

Leyland and Farington Neighbourhood Plan includes the following project:

Lostock Hall and Farington Heritage Trails and Health Walks

Note that this was originally a project on the former Central Neighbourhood Plan. The recent inclusion of Farington into the Leyland area resulted in Members agreeing that projects on the Central plan that were in Farington should be incorporated into the Leyland (now Leyland and Farington) neighbourhood plan.

Background

Health Walk Route Cards have proven very popular across the borough over a number of years with re-prints of several of the routes being required. As well as promoting the wonderful green spaces we have within South Ribble, the new walking route cards encourage residents to exercise as they follow the route highlighted on the card. Central Neighbourhood Forum identified a need to develop a new walking route taking in Farington Moss, which was completed prior to the changes to area boundaries.

The aim of this project was to identify and map out a new self-led Health Walk that will take in Farington Moss and some of its surrounding area, and to fund the re-printing of the two Lostock Hall & Farington Heritage Trail booklets.

Now that the new route has been mapped, the route cards need to be printed, and will be distributed locally via locations such as libraries, local schools & businesses, Doctors' & Dentists' surgeries. We will also hand them out at Neighbourhood forums & local events.

The original project plan included a re-print of the two heritage trails (one of which includes Farington).

It is proposed that the Leyland and Farington neighbourhood forum allocates up to £900 from core funds for the printing of 1,000 A4 folded double sided colour walking cards & the re-print of 1,000 of each of the two Lostock Hall Heritage Trail booklets (which include areas of Farington).
