<p>Upon the advice of the County Council, the Borough Council has previously used the powers available to it under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to achieve the necessary temporary road closures for the Leyland Bonfire, the Remembrance Sunday Parades and Leyland Christmas Festival.</p>

SCHEDULE 1
Leyland Bonfire and Fireworks Display - Tuesday 5 November 2019

On Tuesday 5 November 2019, the following roads will need to be closed between the hours of 5.00pm and 10.00pm to enable a public event to take place safely.

Worden Lane – from its junction with Vicarsfield Road to its junction with B5248 Fox Lane.
B5248 Towngate - from its junction with B5248 Fox Lane to its junction with B5248 Church Road.

B5247 Church Road - from its junction with B5248 Towngate to its junction with Stanning Street.

The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

SCHEDULE 2
Leyland Remembrance Sunday Parade – Sunday 10 November 2019

On Sunday 10 November 2019, the following roads will need to be closed to enable the Parade and Service take place safely between the hours of 10.30am and 1.00pm - West Paddock, Lancastergate, Church Road, St Andrews Way and Broadfield Drive. The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

SCHEDULE 3
Penwortham Remembrance Sunday Parade – Sunday 10 November 2019

On Sunday 10 November 2019, the following roads will need to be closed to enable the Parade and Service to take place safely between the hours of 10.00am and 12noon – Marshalls Brow, Leyland Road, Liverpool Road. The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

SCHEDULE 4
Lostock Hall Remembrance Sunday Parade – Sunday 10 November 2019

On Sunday 10 November 2019, the following roads will need to be closed to enable the Parade and Service to take place safely between the hours of 2.00pm and 4.00pm – Wateringpool Lane, Brownedge Road, Prospect Avenue, Watkin Lane, Jubilee Road. The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

SCHEDULE 5
Leyland Christmas Festival - Saturday 23rd November 2019

On Saturday 23 November 2019, the following road will be closed to enable the Christmas Festival to take place safely between the hours of 7.00am and 9.00pm – Hough Lane. Access to the following roads from Hough Lane will be suspended – Quin Street, Newsome Street, Meadow Street, Thurston Road, Sumner Street. The road closure will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

Access to Quin Street and Newsome Street will be available via Herbert Street and John Street.

Access to Thurston Road and Sumner Street will be available via King Street.

Limited access will be available along the backs to Meadow Street via King Street and Thurston Road.
