Subject: Temporary road closures for the Leyland Bonfire – Saturday 4 November 2017 and Remembrance Sunday Parades in Leyland, Penwortham and Lostock Hall – Sunday 12 November 2017.

Decision: To:
 Authorise the use of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to enable the temporary closure of the streets to allow the Leyland Bonfire and the Remembrance Sunday Parades to take place.
 Note: Details of streets attached.

Details and Reasoning: Upon the advice of the County Council, the Borough Council has previously used the powers available to it under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to achieve the necessary temporary road closures for the Leyland Bonfire, the Remembrance Sunday Parades.

The local police have been consulted and are satisfied with this approach as are the County Council as the Highway Authority. The other emergency services have been consulted together with the 'bus operators as in previous years.





SCHEDULE 1
Leyland Bonfire and Fireworks Display - Saturday 4 November 2017

On Saturday 4 November 2017, the following roads will need to be closed between the hours of 5.30pm and 10.00pm to enable a public event to take place safely.

Worden Lane – from its junction with Vicarsfield Road to its junction with B5248 Fox Lane.
B5248 Towngate - from its junction with B5248 Fox Lane to its junction with B5248 Church Road.

B5247 Church Road - from its junction with B5248 Towngate to its junction with Stanning Street.

The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

SCHEDULE 2
Leyland Remembrance Sunday Parade – Sunday 12 November 2017

On Sunday 12 November 2017, the following roads will need to be closed to enable the Parade and Service take place safely between the hours of 10.30am and 1.00pm - West Paddock, Lancastergate, Church Road, St Andrews Way and Broadfield Drive. The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

SCHEDULE 3
Penwortham Remembrance Sunday Parade – Sunday 12 November 2017

On Sunday 12 November 2017, the following roads will need to be closed to enable the Parade and Service to take place safely between the hours of 10am and 12noon – Marshalls Brow, Leyland Road, Liverpool Road. The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

Lostock Hall Remembrance Sunday Parade – Sunday 12 November 2017

On Sunday 12 November 2017, the following roads will need to be closed to enable the Parade and Service to take place safely between the hours of 2.00pm and 4.00pm – Wateringpool Lane, Browledge Road, Prospect Avenue, Watkin Lane, Jubilee Road.
