Dear Sir

It has come to our attention that the Lancashire Constabulary are seeking a review of The Hunters license for several reasons. We wish to add our concerns to theirs with regard to the anti social behaviour due to excessive noise and loud music both live and recorded.

We live nearby (approximately 0.4 miles) distance from The Hunters but even before Covid restrictions on a "normal" weekend the amount of noise from the venue could be unacceptable. indeed, we have, on occasions, considered calling the Police to complain. Even with our windows closed we cannot hear our own TV unless we increase the sound to such a degree that we could potentially disturb our neighbours! To sit in our garden would not be on our agenda due to the noise and loud music which usually starts early evening until late. Whilst we do not wish to spoil others enjoyment it is only fair that they do not disturb ours and we are shown the same respect. Should we wish to enjoy their entertainment we would visit the venue; as it is we have no choice in the matter.

Throughout the recent football tournament we were bombarded by noise, singing and music not only in the evening but during the day. On the day of the final match excessive noise and singing began at lunchtime and didn't stop until late evening. We even jokingly remarked that we would be amazed if anyone would be sober enough to watch the match as the celebrations became more and more raucous. It was totally unacceptable for us so we dread to think how the households nearer to the venue suffered on the day.

On venturing out the following day (we have been shielding since February 2019 so have been a captive audience on the days they have been allowed to open) the area was like a car park with roads littered with cars obviously left by those not fit enough to drive the previous evening. I must add this was mid afternoon!

It is with reluctance that we contact you but in view of the obvious concerns of the Police feel that now is the time to add our views and concerns.

Please could we request that this email is acknowledged so we know it has arrived safely.
