Background

Over a number of years, Leyland Neighbourhood Forum has supported Christmas events in the Leyland area. The Christmas Festival has become a popular and well attended fixture in the Leyland calendar.

Since 2015, Leyland Town Team has been working with South Ribble Borough Council on a 'Light up Leyland' campaign towards new Christmas lights for the town centre.

The 'Light up Leyland' campaign is now in its third phase, and the Town Team has exciting plans in place. As they have in previous years, they have been fundraising to raise money for the lights and other attractions during the weekend of the Leyland Christmas Festival (24th – 26th November). They have booked a 'snow globe' for the 25th November and a skating rink for 25th -26th November. A pink star has also been commissioned in remembrance of Saffie Roussos who was killed in the Manchester bomb attack.

There have been calls from businesses and the public to extend the light display to Chapel Brow, but the Town Team does not have sufficient funds to cover the cost.

Proposal

The Leyland Forum recognises the significant contribution made by the Town Team to community spirit (and therefore to the *Love Leyland* project). It is proposed that Leyland members request an allocation of core funds up to £3000 to support the Christmas Festival, matching the contribution made by the Town Team.

	The funds will be used to install festive lights on street lighting columns on Chapel Brow, the main approach into the town centre from the railway station. The costings are as follows: Lighting infrastructure £1500 Stage £1500
