

LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire Constabulary have applied to South Ribble Borough Council to review a Premises Licence under section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of the premises known as

Grounds of Review

The application for review is submitted by the Lancashire Constabulary on the grounds that the licensing objectives relating to Crime and Disorder and The Protection of Children from Harm are not being promoted at this premises, there are also concerns about the poor management of the premises.

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is not exceeding £5,000
