**Subject:** Temporary street closures for the St Georges Day Parade on Sunday 22nd April 2018.

**Decision:**  
To:  
Authorise the use of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to enable the temporary closure of the streets to allow the parade to take place.  
Note: Details of streets are attached.

**Details and Reasoning:**

a) Upon the advice of the County Council, the Borough Council has previously used the powers available to it under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 to achieve the necessary temporary road closures for the St Georges Day Parade to take place.

b) The local police have been consulted and are satisfied with this approach as are the County Council as the Highway Authority. The other emergency services have been consulted together with the 'bus operators as in previous years.

On Sunday 22nd April 2018 the following roads will need to be closed in succession between the hours of 1.00pm and 3.00pm to enable the St Georges Day procession to take place safely.

The event will be supervised by a Traffic Management Company.

### **THE SCHEDULE**

#### **PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES**

#### **THE PARADE ROUTE**

From Lostock Hall Recreation Ground, along Croston Road and Jubilee Road,

Watkin Lane – from junction of Jubilee Road to junction with Browndedge Road

Browndedge Road – from junction with Watkin Lane to junction with Avondale Drive

Avondale Drive – entire length

Moss Lane – from junction with Avondale Drive to junction with Watkin Lane

Watkin Lane – from junction with Moss Lane to junction with Jubilee Road

Jubilee Road –entire length and then along Croston Road back to Lostock Hall Recreation Ground.
