Leyland in Bloom 2018

Background

Leyland in Bloom began informally in 2015, with a pleasing standard of entries from individuals and communities. Positive feedback was received from representatives at North West in Bloom, who kindly judged and offered ad hoc support and guidance.

In working with interested residents, it became clear that there was potential for a community committee to be formed, to further develop the Leyland in Bloom concept for 2016 and beyond.

This project was designed to be a community competition to add brightness, colour & pride to our local area so will complement the Love Leyland project also on the Leyland Neighbourhood Plan.

For 2018, Leyland in Bloom will run alongside competitions in the other 4 neighbourhood areas.

Proposal

This year the competition will have 6 categories, with a trophy awarded to the winner of each.

The seven categories are as follows: -

- Front Garden
- Container (domestic only)
- Business / Commercial Premises
- Community Space shared area
- Church / Church Hall
- School Challenge outdoor display with a 'Coming of Peace' theme

As in previous years, judging will be carried out by committee members and elected members, working to a standard set of criteria.

Because the competition is being run across the borough for the first time, we have been able to use generic publicity materials funded by the
