Subject: Fees & Charges for MOT Testing at Moss Side Depot

Decision: To agree the proposed fees and charges for undertaking MOT tests on publicly and privately owned vehicles.

Details and Reasoning: As part of the ongoing development of the services within Neighbourhood Services, improvements have been carried out in the vehicle workshop to enable the authority to carry out MOT tests on its own and other vehicles. The maximum fee chargeable for a test is currently £58.45, it is intended to charge a fee of £45.00 per test and this is felt this to be competitive but is designed not to adversely affect other local garages.

Wider Implications (including Financial, Legal, Equality and Risk):

Financial – The proposed fee is unlikely to have a significant effect on the overall Council budget, the income generated and savings realised are likely to be less than £5,000 initially.

Legal – The terms and condition of accreditation as an MOT Testing Station require the Council to be available to the general public for MOT testing.
